#### Singapore Learning Space (SLS)

- As part of MOE's commitment to nurture future-ready learners, an online learning platform known as the Singapore Student Learning Space (SLS) has been developed.
- With SLS, students will be exposed to curriculum-aligned resources for them to learn at their own pace and collaboratively. Our teachers also design ICT based lessons using SLS to complement classroom teaching. In fact, we harnessed the use of SLS extensively for Home-Based Learning in the last two years!
