Letters from parents will not be accepted, unless there is a valid reason and this is subject to the Principal's approval. Medical certificates from Traditional Chinese Medicine practitioners will not be recognised.
4. For your child's/ward's well-being, students will not be allowed to take any component(s)/ paper(s) if they are unwell on the day of assessment. Please make the necessary arrangements to bring your child/ward to see a doctor and to submit a medical certificate, if he or she is unwell.
5. All students are reminded to bring the necessary stationeries – writing materials, calculators, mathematical instruments and dictionary for Mother Tongue Language Paper 1 for the exam.
